

Facilitating the lesson

Background: In recognition that there may be many schools who do not have access to technology, there are a couple options for facilitating the lesson and as a result varying levels of participation in the champs program evaluation. This document is meant to provide you with a guide on the differences between the delivery methods; and the parts involved for the program evaluation depending on which delivery method is used.

There are two main delivery methods: digital and analogue.

- **Digital delivery** of the lesson is the ideal option for the program evaluation where each student will have access to technology (laptop/tablet device, etc). Teachers will be asked to create an account/class, students will also need to sign up for an account and join the teacher's class. Students using this delivery method will complete 3 'modules' for the evaluation*: (1) pre-trivia of 10 questions, (2) the lesson (3 parts & a quiz to earn vaccines), and (3) a follow-up quiz (quiz of 10 questions).

BEFORE immunization day: (1) pre-trivia quiz to be done by each student AND (2) lesson is taught by HCP and/or teacher. One vaccine will be earned for each student that completes the quiz at the end of the lesson. HCP online survey to be sent by KBI team to be completed.

AFTER immunization day: (3) follow-up quiz is completed by each student (reminder email to be sent to teacher by KBI team to complete this last student step). An online survey for the teacher will be sent by the KBI team to be completed.

- **Analogue delivery** of the lesson is where either the HCP and/or teacher will facilitate the lesson by:
 - Displaying KBI videos on a screen for the whole class to watch (students do not need tablets/laptops)

OR

 - No access to technology (laptop/tablet/smart board) and provides content/activities without videos.

BEFORE immunization day: lesson is taught by HCP and/or teacher, quiz is completed as a group. Certificate of completion awarded to class, 10 vaccines will be donated to UNICEF. Online survey for HCP (if facilitating lesson) is sent by KBI team to be completed.

AFTER immunization day: No further follow-up.

*Timing of the pre-trivia, lesson and follow-up quiz is important as evaluation uses a pre/post design for analyzing the lesson for the grade 6 students.

**Students do not need tablets/laptop but facilitator may use technology to project the lesson on a screen or to display videos and activity questions, if available

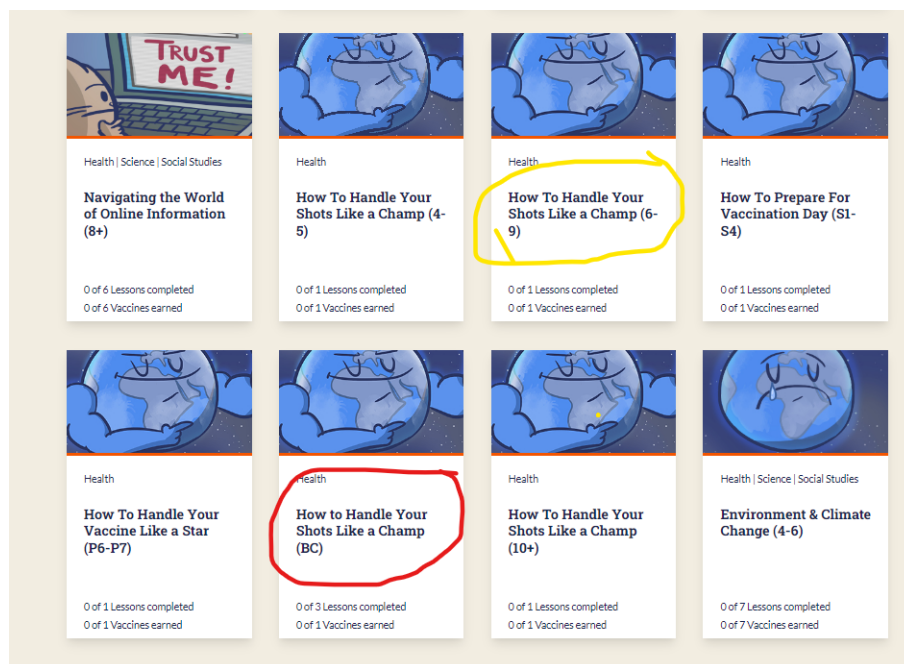
Locating the lesson:

Scroll down and click on the lesson icon according to your method of delivery:



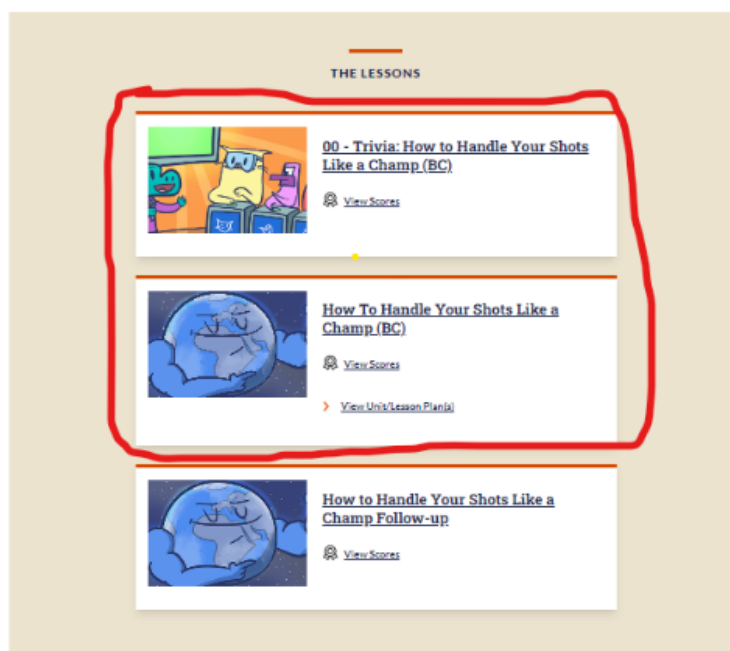

For Digital delivery: Click on the How to Handle Your Shots Like a Champ (BC) icon (circled in red in image 2 above).

Once you are on the page, you will see 3 lessons. On lesson day, you will first have the students individually complete the (1) 00 - Trivia: How to Handle Your Shots Like a Champ (BC) quiz, and then once they have completed this you will then move on to teaching (2) How to Handle Your Shots Like a Champ (BC) lesson. At the end of the lesson the students will individually complete the quiz to earn vaccines towards UNICEF.

The third and final 'lesson' on this page - How to Handle Your Shots Like a Champ *Follow-up* - will be completed AFTER the immunization clinic happens. **It is important that the students DO NOT do the follow-up quiz until after the immunization clinic.** An email will be sent by the KBI team to the classroom teacher as a reminder to have the students complete this last follow-up quiz. Students will be asked to sign back into their accounts and complete a post-clinic quiz. The HCP is not responsible for this step (for your reference only).

For Analogue delivery: Click on the [How to Handle Your Shots Like a Champ \(6-9\)](#) icon (circled in yellow in image 2 above)

Once you are on the page, click on the lesson title hyperlink (not > view unit/lesson plan). After all parts of the lesson are done, the quiz will be completed as a group. A certificate of completion will be awarded after the quiz has been completed (HCP or teacher fills out) and sends to champs@kidsboostimmunity.com. Once received, the class will earn 10 vaccines to be donated to UNICEF.

HCP Champ Checklist

Digital delivery
