WHAT IS IT?

KBI is a free, online, educational resource developed specifically for educators to deliver curriculum materials in a highly engaging way. There are close to 700 lessons available for teachers that span grades 2-12. Lessons are available in French and in English.

USING KBI IN MY CLASSROOM

There are a variety of ways to use KBI in your classroom. These ways include, enhancing your lessons, introducing a topic, reviewing a topic, using this program in small groups or using this for quick finishers.

BENEFITS OF KBI

1. Teacher Centre

This resource was designed with teachers in mind. It has a teacher centre that has year-long plans connected to curriculum, unit and lesson plans, and hand-outs that can be used for free.

2. Curriculum Content

This resource is developed by teaching, health and science experts for Canadian teachers. There are lessons from grade 2-12 directly linked to the Canadian curriculums across all provinces.

3. Global Citizenship

This resource provides students with a unique opportunity to help others around the world by providing much needed vaccines, all while learning curriculum material. It works in any classroom either teacher-led with no computers needed for students, or students doing lessons individually online.

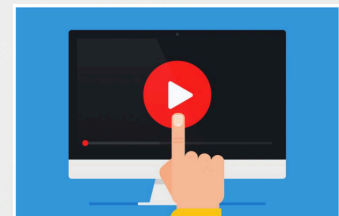
