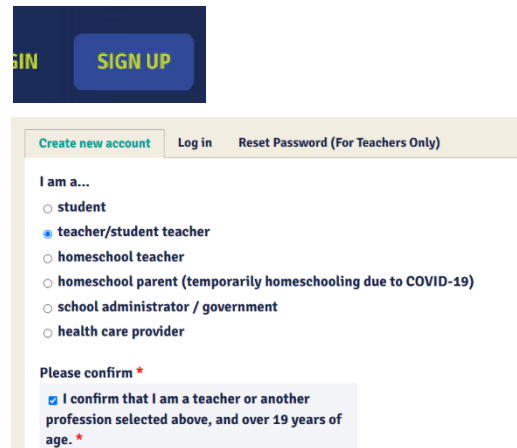


Sign-up for a teacher account on Kids Boost Immunity. It's easy!

1. Go to www.kidsboostimmunity.com
2. Click on **SIGN-UP** on the top right corner.
3. Click on **teacher/student teacher** under Create new account.

Confirm that you are a teacher

4. Fill in the necessary information:
 - First & last name
 - City, Province
 - Phone number
 - Password
 - Email
 - School organization/District
 - Select subject(s) you teach



5. **Click on the Create new account** button.
This takes a few seconds.

6. KBI will approve a school email teacher account quickly (within 24 hours but usually within 1-2 hours).

Respond to a confirmation email that might be in your SPAM/JUNK folder and you then have a KBI teacher account for as long as you use this email. **No need to ever sign up again.**

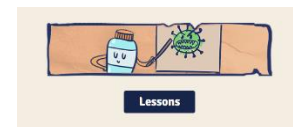

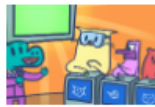

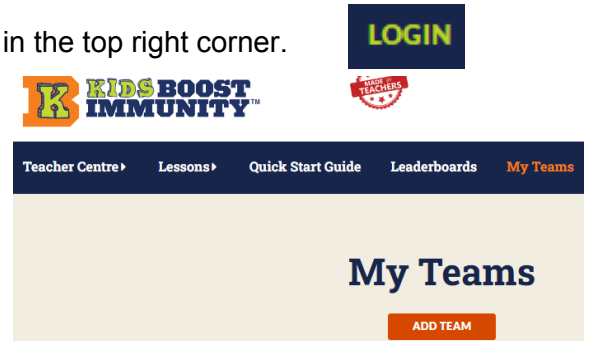

Instructions for creating a class/team

1. Go to www.kidsboostimmunity.com and click on **LOGIN** in the top right corner.
2. Go to **My Teams** on the menu as shown.
3. Click on Add Team.
4. To create a team/class, follow the simple instructions on the site. A number of steps are optional.



NOTE -The most important step is creating a 'team registration code'.

This is a combination of YOUR last name and a unique phrase. This is the code that students will use to join the team.

In the example below, the teacher's last name is Miller. The unique phrase they have created is 2025test.

NOTE – teachers do not have to put in their last name as it is automatically generated. The class/team code is miller-2025test.

This team's registration code is your last name + your unique phrase.

Kids OFFLINE Mode Teachers do lessons and quizzes in class. Students take part in quizzes in class and do not go online. The teacher completes quizzes on behalf of the class based on quiz results collected from students.

Kids ONLINE Mode Students sign up to the teacher's class/team using the class code and complete lessons and quizzes online individually.

- Students are required to enter this code when they sign up only, and this code determines which team/class they join.
- Decide how best to share this code with students (preferably electronically so they can copy & paste).
- For tracking passwords, teachers can record individual student passwords when they first make their account. Or reset forgotten passwords if needed.

NOTE - Teachers can make as many classes/teams as they like.
